

WOKING URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL ELECTION RESULTS 1915-1938

After the First World War the 'Representation of the People Act 1918', gave all men over the age of twenty-one and women over the age of thirty the right to vote (and stand as candidates). Woking's first female councillor was Lady Elizabeth Balfour, representing the St John's Ward as an 'independent' - although like her husband, Gerald (and his brother, the former Prime Minister Arthur Balfour), she was undoubtedly a Conservative (with a huge 'c').

From then on there would never be less than one female councillor in Woking, although men still dominated local politics. Political 'parties' were also more prominent in the inter-war period with the 'Progressive Party', Labour and the local Co-operative movement putting up candidates—the latter without success. Claude Nash too was unsuccessful in winning support as an 'ex-serviceman' in 1921, as was Edward Miller in 1938-9 as the 'King's & People's Champion'.

The most successful grouping during this period was undoubtedly the 'Resident's Association' candidates, including those from Byfleet Resident's Association who dominated the poll in that village when Byfleet, West Byfleet and Pyrford joined with Woking from the now defunct Chertsey Rural District Council in 1933.

But as most of the 'Resident' candidates faded away (some converting to 'independents'), the main issue of the 1937 election was undoubtedly the move by the 'anti incorporationists' against the proposal of Woking to become a 'Borough' with all that that entailed. They may not have won any seats - the council being solidly 'independent' up to and including the Second World War—but their argument obviously prevailed (at the time).

After the war, Woking Council would never be the same again.
