W H E R E A S The Reverend Frederick James Oliphant M.A. Vicar of the Vicarage of Woking in the County of Surrey Clerk in Holy Orders the person interested under the provisions of "The Inclosure Acts 1845 to 1878" in the land and hereditaments specified in the first schedule hereunder written situate in the Parish of Woking in the said County of Surrey and The London Necropolis and National Mausoleum Company of No. 5 Lancaster Place Strand London the persons interested under the provisions of the said Acts in the land and hereditaments specified in the second schedule hereunder written also situate in the said Parish of Woking being desirous of effecting an exchange of the same lands and hereditaments made due application to the Land Commissioners for England to direct enquiries respecting and to proceed with the same under the provisions of the said Acts

NOW The Land Commissioners for England in pursuance of the said Inclosure Acts DO by this Order of Exchange under their hands and seal order and declare that the land and hereditaments specified in the First schedule hereunder written and shown on the plan hereunto annexed with the rights easements and appurtenances thereto belonging shall be taken by and henceforward become and be the land and hereditaments of the said London Necropolis and National Mausoleum Company in exchange for the land and hereditaments specified in the second schedule hereunder written and also shown on the said plan

AND that the said land and hereditaments specified in the said second schedule and shown on the said plan with the rights easements and appurtenances thereto belonging shall be taken by and henceforward become and be the land and hereditaments of the said Frederick James Oliphant as such Vicar as aforesaid in exchange for the said land and hereditaments specified in the said first schedule and shown on the said plan as aforesaid

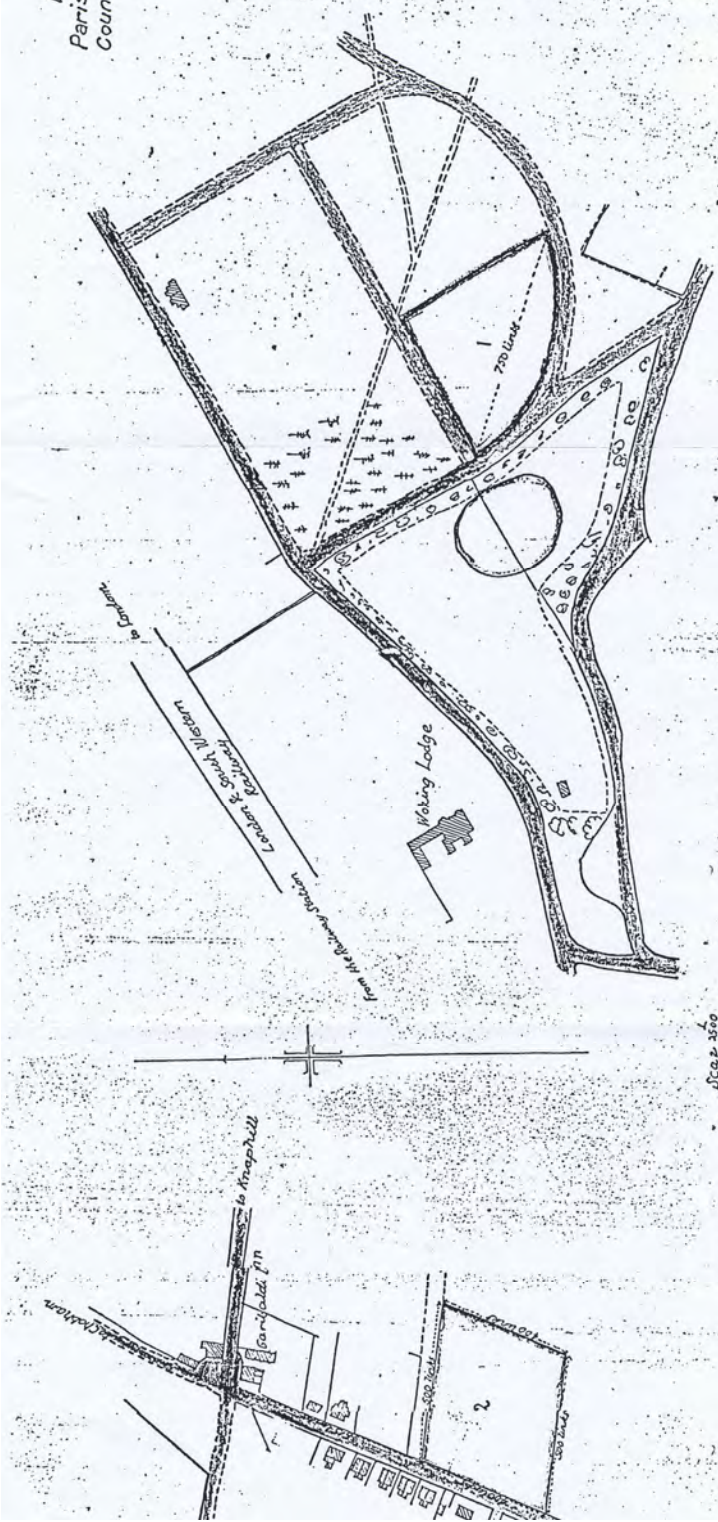
