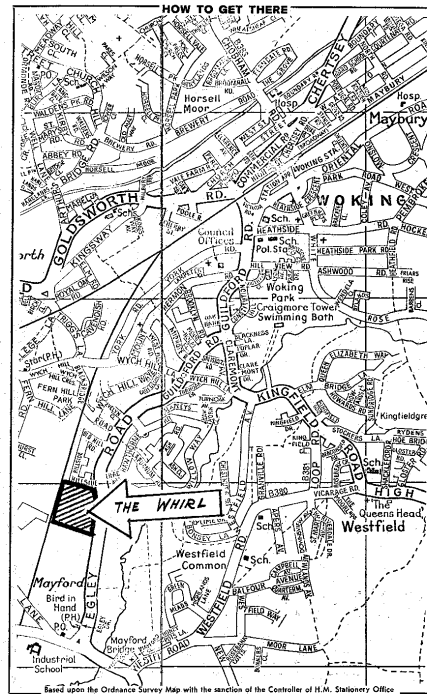

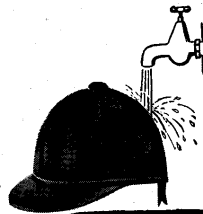

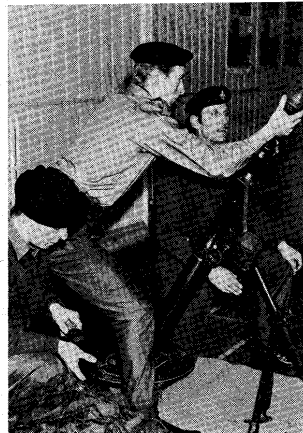

After opening fire (blanks only — don't worry!) the section will advance, debus and attack again — with rapid fire.

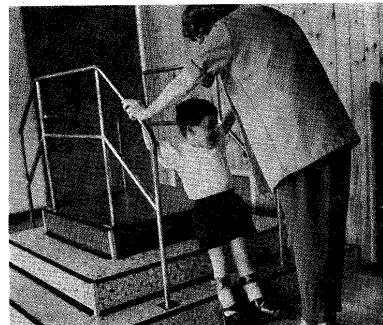

WHITE LODGE CENTRE has been operational for seven years and now provides all-day care and treatment for 40 children, in addition to providing 35 children, as out-patients, with physiotherapy, speech-therapy & hydro-therapy.

At last it has become possible to begin work on long-planned extensions, and these will provide better conditions for the work amongst the children as well as making more places available.

These extensions will cost £30,000 and, at present, some £7,000 are still needed. Annual running costs, it is estimated, will rise by a further £2,000. WHITE LODGE is very grateful that part of the proceeds of WOKING WHIRL will be helping to pay for this very worthwhile work.

THE BLACK KNIGHTS Free Fall Display Team



By kind permission of the Officer Commanding 7th Parachute Regiment Royal Horse Artillery, we are to witness a display by these leading exponents of the art of free fall parachuting. The black-suited, white-helmeted gunners will approach at a height of about 10,000 ft. in their De Havilland Rapide and we will witness their rapid descent from the aeroplane; no doubt many will wonder just how long it will be before the parachutes open. Rest assured that they will, and do not be concerned when you see holes in the parachutes, which really are intended to be there.

So complete is the control exercised by the parachutists that on occasions they are able to pass a baton between them whilst in descent. You may be interested to know that the parachutists are falling at the rate of 120 miles per hour in almost 45 seconds and during this time we can follow their descent quite clearly by trails from the smoke bombs attached to their boots.

There is no doubt that, weather permitting, we shall enjoy a spectacle of incomparable excitement and skill.



GOING UP

WITH THE HOT AIR BALLOON

Some of us in Woking have witnessed before the inflation and flight of the balloon. In fact it has proved so popular that we are delighted to welcome to the Whirl, Wing Commander G. F. Turnbull, M.B.E., A.F.C., and his band of helpers.

Listen carefully to the detailed commentary and if you too want to be "up, up and away" it may interest you to know that the inflation and launching of a hot air balloon can vary from the poetic to the traumatic. In low wind conditions, of 5 m.p.h. or less, the inflation and launching is pure magic. The balloon is laid down wind, with the basket, load ring and burner in line and on their side. The pilot, gloved and helmeted, sits on the ground behind the burner and lights the pilot light. Two helpers lift the sides of the balloon and hold it up, while a third helper goes to the crown of the balloon and holds it firmly to the ground. The fourth team member stands inside the open mouth of the balloon and with his hands upraised holds the fabric aloft. At a signal the pilot turns on the main burner, aims the roaring flame at the ground and gradually raises it and points it towards the man inside the balloon. As he feels the intense heat he backs away into the balloon, pressing the fabric up above his head and allowing the hot air to flow in.

Within seconds a huge bubble of air has formed and the "inside man" has retreated well into the balloon. The flame is doused momentarily and he ducks out quickly and gasps in the cool air. The flame roars out again and the balloon strains to lift the crown holder off the ground. Another signal, the crown holder lets go and the huge balloon leaps up into the air, pulling the burner with it and righting the basket. The pilot turns off the flame, scrambles into the basket and re-ignites. The burner roars steadily, the balloon fills to capacity and the basket shifts uneasily on the ground. The pilot signals for the passengers to scramble aboard and within four minutes of the first burst of flame the balloon ascends majestically into the air. Instantly the burner is extinguished and the balloon climbs 200-300 feet in absolute silence. At its apogee another short burst of flame and the cross-country flight has begun.

Apart from the capital outlay, the cost of obtaining a Hot Air Balloon Private Pilot's Licence is not much more than the cost of obtaining a licence to drive a car. Budding enthusiasts should write to the British Balloon and Airship Club at Artillery Mansion, 75 Victoria Street, London, S.W.1, and ask for details of membership.

At present there are under two dozen qualified balloon pilots in Great Britain. Why not join this exclusive company?

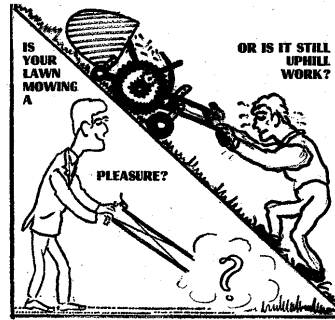
