ABOUT THE FRIENDS

The Friends of Manor County Infants School was formed in May, 1969, with the following Aims and Objects:

1. To establish and maintain a liaison between parents and staff.
2. To encourage parents and other local residents to maintain a constructive interest in the School and to make their practical contribution towards the common good.
3. To provide opportunities for talks and activities concerned with current educational theory and practice.
4. To provide equipment not otherwise available to the school.

In September, 1970, the Friends began to publish its own newsletter, called simply 'Friends'. This is now regarded as a useful communications medium covering reports on activities past and in the future, topics of interest and feature articles on personalities in and around the school.

Membership has grown steadily during the years of operation and is expected to exceed 200 in the current year.

The annual subscription per family is 20p.
