

starting at **8pm** beside the **Village Sign, Old Woking**,
at the junction of the High Street (B382) and Broadmead Road (A247)

Free, long-stay, parking is available on the opposite side
of the mini-roundabout in the larger car park
(beyond the first, short stay area).

There is no guarantee, but we hope to see some of the owls and deer that live
in the vicinity as we traipse across the meadows to Woking Palace.
As the meadows can be quite damp and overgrown in places (the walk is not
on public footpaths), suitable footwear and clothing should be worn.
The return, after sunset, will be via Carter's Lane, so please bring a torch.
