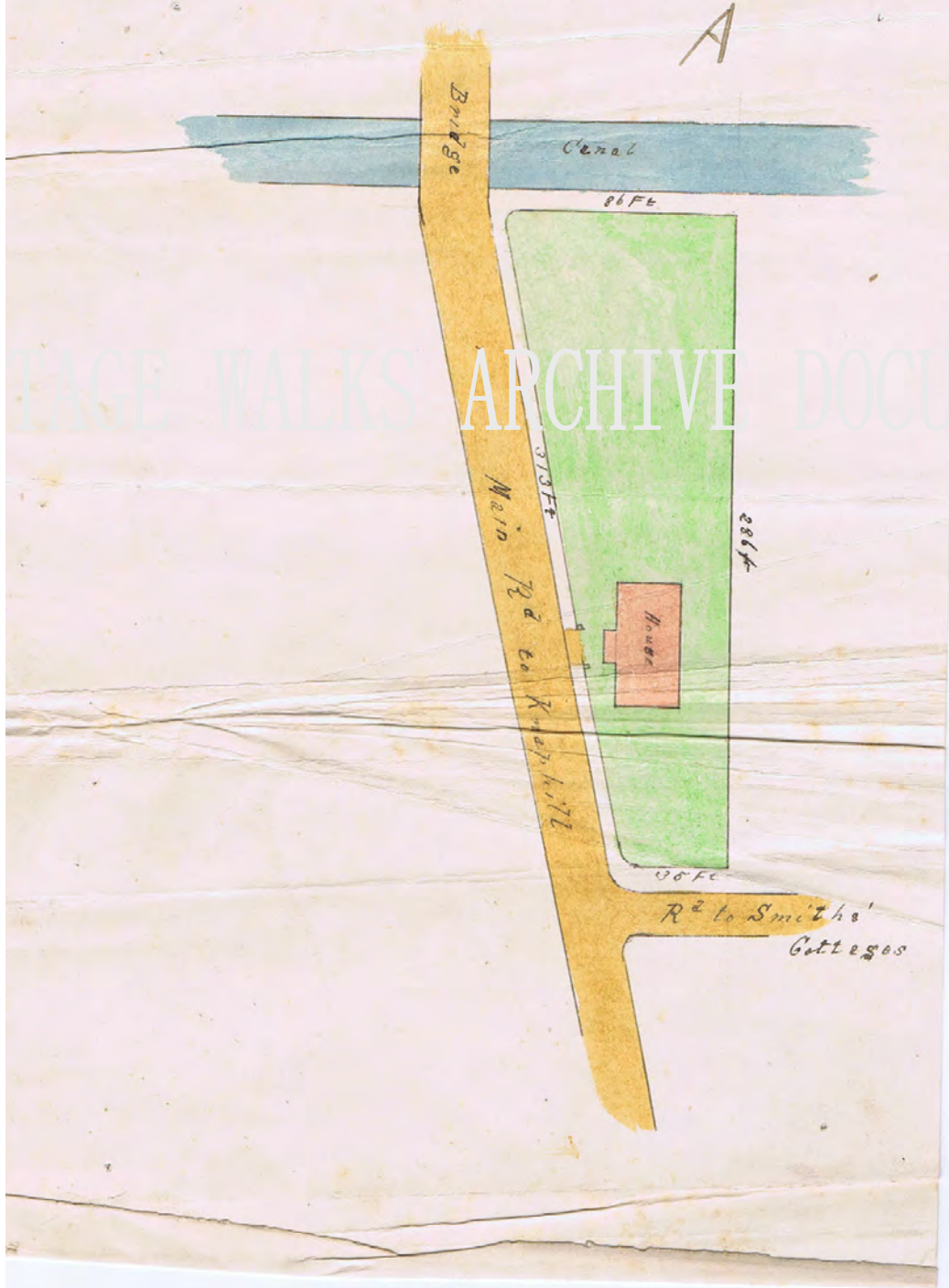

III, c. 125, and the provision contained in the Act of the 16th & 17th Vict., c. 74, and the Rules and Directions therein respectively contained.
