**NOTES ON**

**STORING AND SERVING WINES**

**1 Temperature and Preparation for Serving**

Wine should be stored in a uniform temperature from 50° to 60° F. Varying temperatures and draughts are extremely harmful.

All old wines should be stood up for about 12 hours before decanting to allow any loose deposit to settle.

**2 Decanting**

1. Remove the whole of the metal capsule, all wax, dirt and dust on or near the cork before drawing it.
2. Place the point of the corkscrew exactly in the centre of the cork and drive it slowly into the cork.
3. Draw the cork without jerking and without moving the bottle more than you can possibly help.
4. Always use a napkin to hold the bottle when drawing the cork, for fear of a split neck.
5. Wipe the lip of the bottle carefully after the cork has been drawn.

6. Pour a little of the wine into a spare glass from every freshly-opened bottle and smell wine carefully to make sure it is not corky or otherwise defective.

7. Decant wine with neither haste nor hesitation. Place a lighted candle or an electric bulb behind the shoulder of the bottle and watch the wine as it passes through the neck of the bottle. When the first signs of sediment are seen, cease decanting.

**3 Glasses**

It is essential that all glasses and decanters are dry and absolutely clean, to obtain the full character of all wines.

COCKTAIL RECIPES *especially chosen for the occasion*

**SIMPLE RULES FOR MIXING COCKTAILS**  
Always remember that a little too much of some ingredients can ruin the cocktail. Ice should go first into the shaker, other ingredients in any order you like. Always use clean ice, and never handle with fingers. Remember, too, that many a cocktail has been ruined by adding too much Bitters or Cordial.
