

The success of 'Labour' and 'Trademen's Alliance' candidates prior to 1902 was not matched during the Edwardian era with Mr Cox still not managing to gain election even in years when his "Labour" tag was not highlighted!

It was not until 1910 that the 'Independent's' on the council were seriously challenged by the 'People's Rights Association'. For a brief spell they managed to gain five seats and become the largest 'political' party on the council, until 1914 when once again party politics was taken out of local elections in the town.

The biggest change to Woking Council came in 1907, however, after Horsell voted to leave the fast disintegrating Chertsey Rural District Council and join with Woking.
