Retirement by rotations is easy to provide for in a simple form of Constitution but not so easy in the more complicate Constraint by the Council but some of the Conneil retire annually and some go on from year to year, it is advisable, therefore, before attempting to vary this clause so as to provide for a system of rotation, to give careful consideration also to the way in which the Council is appointed.

(III) The Auditors are the 'watchdogs' of the members and of the gene lic and it is therefore important that they should be appointed at the General Meeting. The term 'qualified' means any person who is a me any body of accountants.
