or to make a booking)

Free, long-stay, parking is
available in Old Woking in
the larger car park (beyond
the first, short stay area)
behind Manor Mews, at
the junction of the High
Street (B382) and
Broadmead Road (A247)
SATNAV use GU22 9JH

Mainly looking at
the history of the area in
the mid-17th century -
between the
beheading of Charles I
and the restoration of
Charles II

Start 2.00pm on the
Cartbridge at Send for a walk
up-stream to Triggs Lock and
then to Old Woking, finishing at
the Village Sign
(or return to Send via
Broadmead Road)
